

## Membership Subscription:

The rates of subscription for various categories of members will be according to the financial year i.e. April 01 to March 31 and are as follows:

- Life Membership ₹ 4,000.00 (Inland)  
US \$ 350.00 (Foreign) or equivalent
- Ordinary Membership ₹ 400.00 per annum (Inland)  
US \$ 125.00 (Foreign) or equivalent
- Sessional Membership ₹ 200.00 per annum (Inland)  
US \$ 100.00 (Foreign) or equivalent
- Student Membership ₹ 200.00 per annum (Inland)
- Institutional Membership ₹ 20,000.00 (Inland) (Permanent)  
US \$ 1,500.00 (Foreign) or equivalent
- Institutional Membership ₹ 2,000.00 per annum (Inland) (Annual)  
US \$ 300.00 per annum (Foreign) or equivalent
- Subscription to Journal ₹ 1000.00 per volume (Inland)  
US \$ 120.00 per volume (Foreign) or equivalent

Besides the subscription, enrolment fee of ₹ 10.00 (Inland) and US \$ 5.00 (Foreign) will have to be paid by everyone enrolling as ordinary/student member.

- Life membership fee may be paid in 2 or 3 instalments on request within the year of enrolment as member, i.e. from April 01 to March 31.

- Any ordinary member of the Society may convert his membership into a life membership on payment of a composition fee which will be calculated as follows:

- For members in India: ₹ 4,000.00 minus a rebate of 50% of the subscription already paid subject to a maximum of ₹ 1600.00.
- For foreign members US \$ 350.00 or its equivalent minus a rebate of 50% for every year's subscription already paid subject to a maximum of US \$ 130.00.

- Only those members will be entitled to the benefit of conversion who have made up to date payment towards their ordinary membership fee.

- If the subscription is sent by cheque, the collection charges should be added to the amount of the cheque. When sent by Money Order (M.O.), the M.O. commission should not be deducted from the amount of subscription.

- The membership may cease if the subscription is in arrears for two years. During this period, the members will continue to be treated as members but, issues of the Journal may not be sent to such members for the period for which membership fee has not been paid.

- Should a defaulting member wish to re-enroll, he/she may do so as a new member provided: The member pays arrears for one year, or becomes life member by paying the full fee of ₹ 4,000.00 notwithstanding any past payments made.
