

Professor ALOKE DEY, formerly Professor and currently, a Senior Scientist of the Indian National Science Academy (INSA) at the Indian Statistical Institute, New Delhi received the National Award in Statistics (instituted in the memory of Professor P.V. Sukhatme by the Ministry of Statistics and Programme Implementation, Government of India) from the Hon'ble Vice President of India, Shri M. Hamid Ansari on the Statistics Day, June 29, 2010. This was in recognition of the outstanding contributions of Professor Dey in theoretical and applied statistics. His research contributions encompass several diverse areas such as Design of Experiments, Sampling Theory, Linear Algebra and Engineering. His research work has been extensively cited globally. In addition, Professor Dey is the author/coauthor of 6 (six) books, which have been received very well in academic circles and have received numerous citations.



Professor Dey is a life member of the Indian Society of Agricultural Statistics. He has served on the Editorial Board of the Journal of the Indian Society of Agricultural Statistics for many years and is at present a Vice President of the Society. He is a Fellow of two science academies, viz., the Indian National Science Academy and the National Academy of Sciences, India. He is also an elected Member of the International Statistical Institute.
