THE VENUE

The Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR) established the National Research Centre on Rapeseed-Mustard (NRCRM) on October 20, 1993 and redesignated it as the Directorate of Rapeseed-Mustard Research (DRMR) in February 2009 to carry out basic, strategic and applied research on rapeseed-mustard. Besides, generating basic knowledge and material, the Directorate is also engaged in developing ecologically sound and economically viable agro production and protection technologies. The Directorate has the responsibility of planning, coordination and execution of research programmes through wide network of 11 main, 13 sub- and 22 verification centres across the country to augment the production and productivity of rapeseed-mustard.

LOCATION

The Directorate is located on Agra-Jaipur national highway and is 7 km far from Bharatpur railway station and 3 km from bus station. Internationally known for Keoladeo National Bird Sanctuary, Bharatpur is on Delhi-Bombay main railway track just 35 km ahead of Mathura. Bharatpur is well connected with Jaipur, Delhi and Agra by road.

CLIMATE

The Conference is being organized during November 2017 which is the best time to visit Bharatpur. Winter starts falling at Bharatpur in the month of November, during which the maximum temperature falls down to about 27°C while the minimum temperature is around 3.5°C.

THE CITY OF BHARATPUR

Bharatpur, also known as 'Lohagarh', is located in the Braj region 180 km away from Delhi. Bharatpur is believed to be a place of mythological importance. It is believed that the Pandavas had spent their 13th year of exile at this place around 3,500 years ago. Archaeologists have found

many ancient specimens which are presently kept in the Bharatpur museum.

Maharaja Surajmal, the erstwhile ruler of Bharatpur State was known for his political sagacity, steady intellect and clear vision.

The nearest airport is situated at Agra, which is 56 kms from Bharatpur. Regular rail services connect Bharatpur with all the major cities such as Delhi, Mumbai, Kolkata, Jaipur and Agra. The Bharatpur railway station is about 5 kms from the park/bird sanctuary. Bharatpur is a very popular tourist spot in Rajasthan. The Bharatpur Bird Sanctuary also called as Keoladeo Ghana National Park is the most popular tourist spot among tourists. Another attraction is Deeg which is beautiful garden town 30 kms away, in north of Bharatpur. The gardens have been laid with great care and precision, the sparkling fountains and meticulous palaces add to the beauty of this idyllic retreat of the princes of Bharatpur. In addition to these, there are many other places of interest such as Bharatpur Museum, Purana Mahal and Lohagarh fort.
