GREGOR-JOHANN MENDEL COMMITTEE ON AGRICULTURAL STATISTICS

The primary purpose was to provide a forum within the International Statistical Institute for the exchange of statistical methodology among Agricultural Statisticians. This panel of experts would hopefully meet as a special topic session at the Beijing Conference. The panel of experts would be identified early enough so that participants could either prepare questions in advance or bring them to the meeting.
- Arrange an open meeting of the committee and all interested agricultural statisticians at the Beijing conference to discuss future activities.
