I. STATISTICAL METHODS IN ANIMAL SCIENCES

V.N. AMBLE

The book has been prepared at the instance of the Indian Society of Agricultural Statistics for specially meeting the needs of the student and the research worker in animal sciences wishing to learn the basic principles and the principal procedures of statistics for use in planning investigation and in analysing and interpreting the data. The emphasis in the book is on the principles and procedures with an attempt at elucidating the logic without too much of mathematics. A special feature of the book is the illustrations of the procedures through examples all taken from the field of animal sciences which would help the research worker in animal sciences in understanding the applications all the more easily. Only basic knowledge of algebra at elementary level is assumed and the few derivations of procedures from statistical theory given in the book have been presented such a manner that while they meet to some extent the logical inquisitiveness of a class of readers they could be omitted without loss of a clear understanding of the procedures.

The book consists of 17 chapters. The first 9 deal with statistical methods of inference and the next 7 with the planning of experiments and the analysis mainly on experimental data. The last chapter deals with the elements of sampling.
